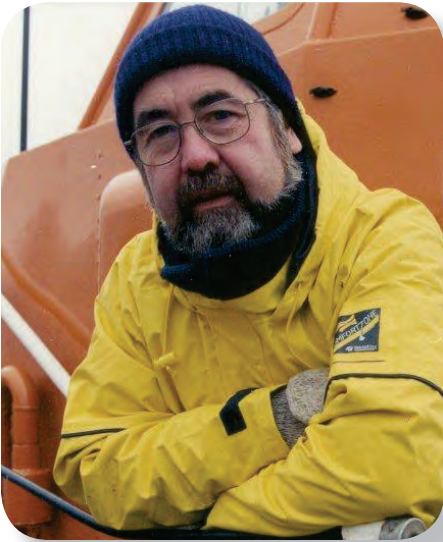


CAPTAIN'S MESSAGE

Welcome to the Roberts Bank Lifeboat Station Delta Society and the Roberts Bank Lifeboat.

The Roberts Bank Lifeboat Delta Station Society is a volunteer nonprofit provincially registered charitable marine search and rescue organization. It is dedicated to saving lives and property in our community along the Fraser River and in the Strait of Georgia.

The Society is the administrative and funding organization that provides the essential support for the Roberts Bank Lifeboat presently operating from Ladner Harbour and from Roberts Bank Container Terminal.

In March of 2010 the Society is celebrating 10 years of community support for the lifeboat, the only dedicated marine rescue resource in Delta.

Professionally trained volunteer crew is on call 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. They respond within 30 minutes to any launch request from the municipal, port or federal first response agencies.

Volunteers are from the Delta community and from all walks of life, and show their concern about safety on the water and adjacent lands by providing crew on the vessel, administrative support, fund-raising, or boat maintenance.

We also provide a platform for both the Delta Police and Delta Fire Rescue Departments. Each year undertake voluntary vessel inspections to raise awareness of safety on the water around the community.
